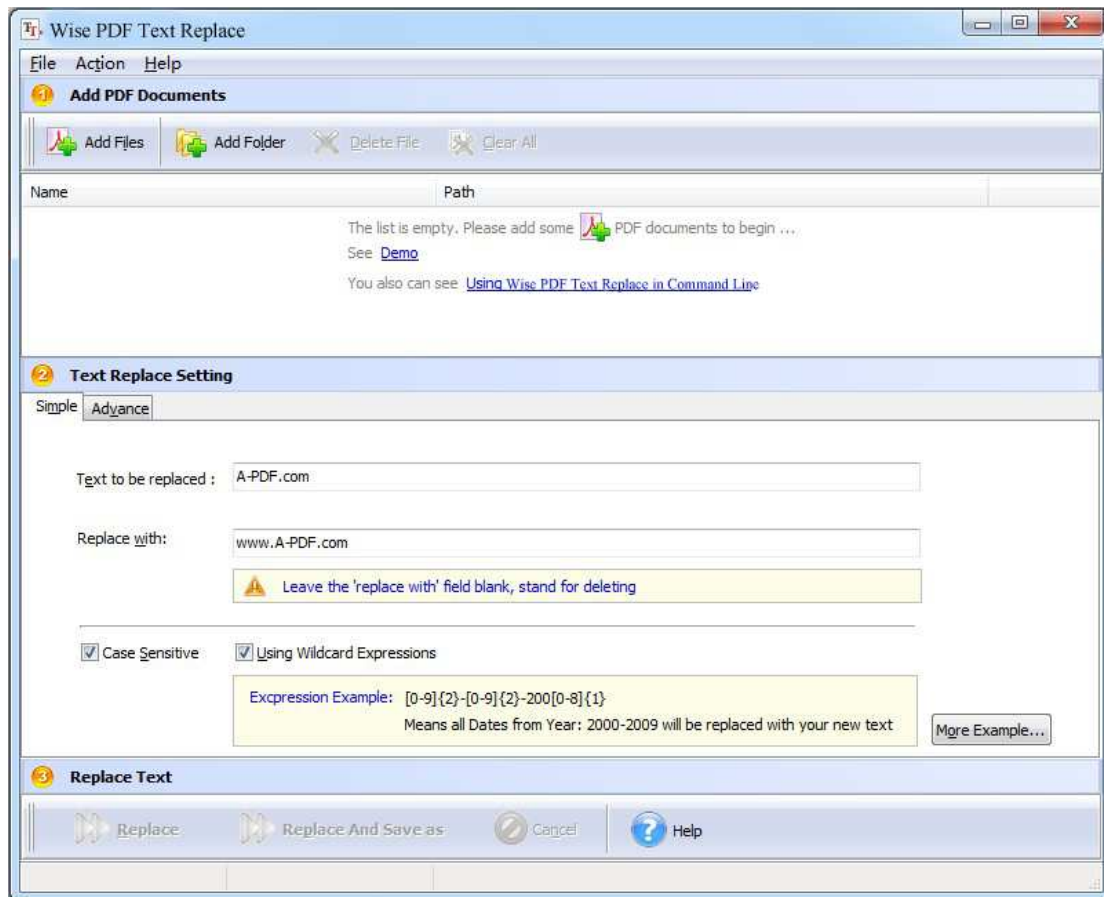
**Note:** This product has a free trial version, all features in this document are useful for you. There is no any watermark in your merging pdf files if you use the registered version.

### (1) All features of Wise PDF Text Replace

- ▲ A straightforward operation interface
- ▲ Modify the text of PDF files at a high speed
- ▲ Case sensitive options
- ▲ Replace the text with Wildcard expressions mode
- ▲ Command line operation
- ▲ Operation systems like Win98/ME/NT/2000/XP/vista/Win7 are supported

### (2) Using Wise PDF Text Replace

You can start Wise PDF Text Replace by clicking the desktop shortcut on the computer desktop.



### (3) Command line mode

Usage:

```
PTRCMD.exe <Source PDF> <Destination PDF> <Original Text>
           <New Text> [<Original Text> <New Text> ... ]
           [-C<Y/N>]
```

#### Parameters

<Source PDF>: Source PDF file.  
<Output PDF>: Specifies the name for the output file.  
<Original Text>: The text in the source file that will be replaced.  
<New Text>: The new text will be replaced with.  
The "\$EMPTY\$" string stand for blank, which means deleting the <Original Text>.  
[-C<Y/N>]: Specifies the texts are case sensitive or not.

#### Return code:

0: Success  
2: Input file does not exist  
3: The parameters are invalid.  
4: Load PDF error!  
5: Password error!  
6: Nonsupport security.

#### example:

```
PTRCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "old text" "new text"
PTRCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "old text1" "new text1" "old text2"
"new text2" -CY
PTRCMD "C:\input.pdf" "C:\output.pdf" "old text1" "new text1" "old text2"
"new text2" -CN
```

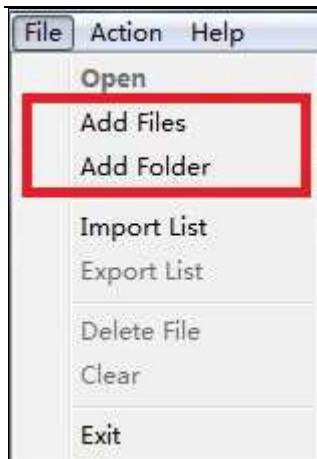
#### (4)Add PDF files


There are four kinds of methods for you to add your PDF files.

**First**, you can click the icon of  directly on the operation interface and select any PDF files you want to deal with.

**Second**, you can click the icon of  and add your PDF files to Wise PDF Text Replace.

**Third**, you can just click “Add files” or “Add folder” to add PDF files.



**Four**, you can just click the icon of  to add PDF files.



### (5)Text Replace Settings

Wise PDF Text Replace provides you with detailed options. Case sensitive option allows you to choose whether to replace the capital words or not in a short time. It also allows you to replace multiple texts in advanced options and you can delete some of useless texts in PDF files.

Wildcard expression mode is a quick and flexible way for you to replace different texts in a high rate.

For example, if you would like to replace multiple texts like “Apple A”, “Apple B” and “Apple C”, you can enter “Apple ( A| B| C)” in the “Text to be replaced”, and replaced with “Apple D”.

#### ● Simple Settings

Just enter the text which is to be replaced in the box of “Text to be replaced”, and it will be replaced with the text in the box of “Replace with”.

### ● Advanced Settings

Advanced Settings allow you to batch replacing the text.
