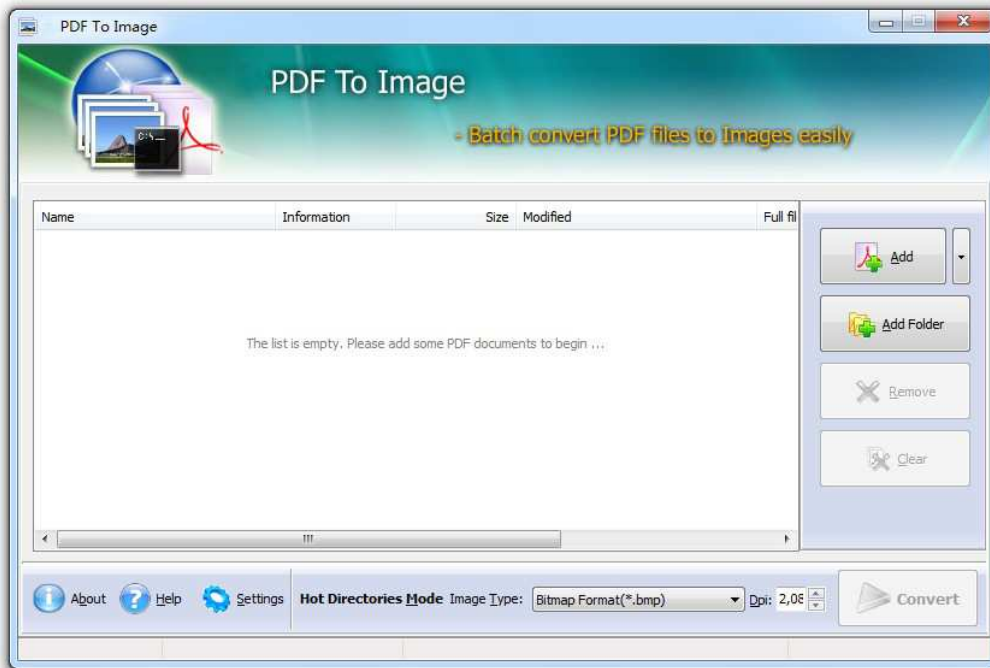

(1) All features of Wise PDF to Image

- ▲ A particular and professional operation interface
- ▲ Batch converting one or more PDF files to image files

(2) Using Wise PDF to Image

You can start Wise PDF to Image by clicking the desktop shortcut on the computer desktop.



(3) Add PDF files

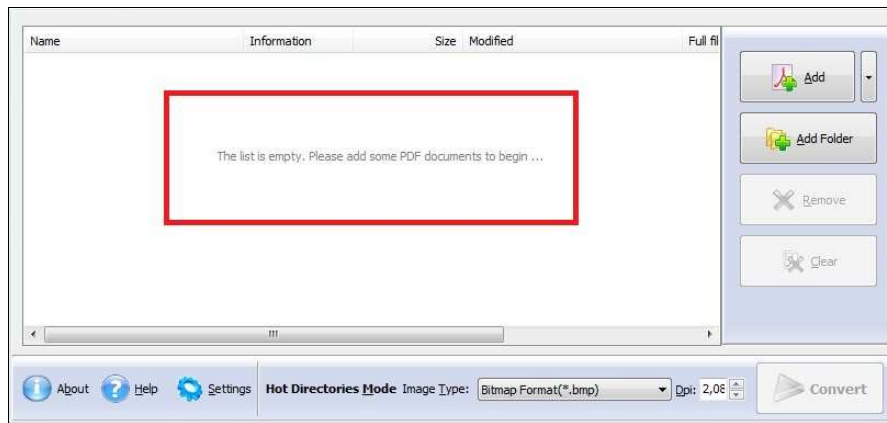
There are three kinds of methods for you to add your PDF files.

First, you can click the icon of  directly on the operation interface and select any PDF files you want to deal with.

Second, you can click the icon of “add folder” and select to add a folder of PDF files





Third, you can just click the blank space to add PDF files.



(4) Delete PDF files

If you want to delete PDF files which are unneeded, you can pitch on that file and

click the icon of . If you want to delete all PDF files, you can click the icon of  to remove all of them completely.

(5) Command line mode

If you are familiar with computer program, you can also operate it by command line mode.

Usage:

```
Pdfpti <input PDF file> <output Path>

Return code:
 1: Does not find GhostSscript
 2: Input file does not exist
 3: Invalid Output file path
 5: Source file is not PDF file (.PDF)
 6: Convert Failed
 8: Convert successfully
10: Error because another A-PDF To Image is running.

An example:
Pdfpti "c:\Scanned.PDF " "c:\output\"
```

- ▲ TIFF

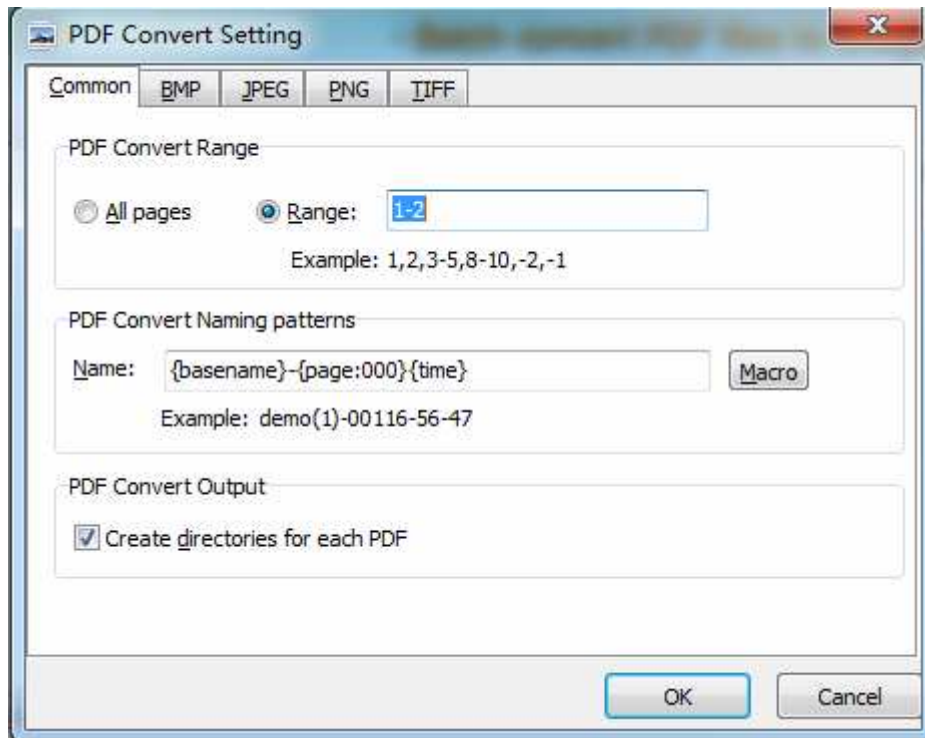
(7) Professional options

Name Patterns: Define different kinds of name patterns.

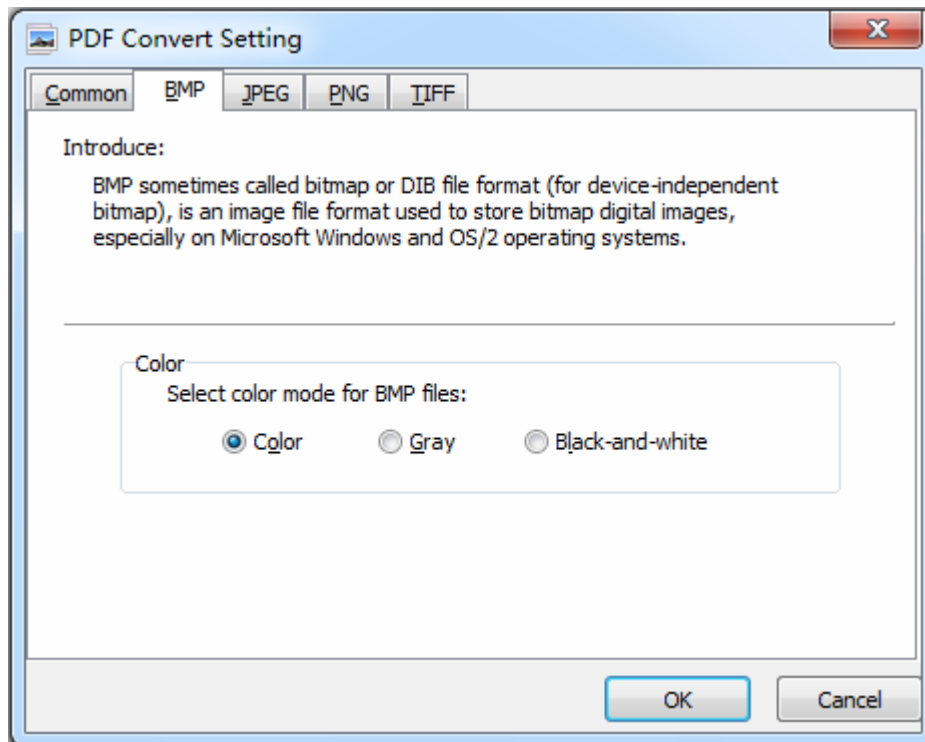
Outputting Ways: Choose whether to create directories for each PDF nor not.



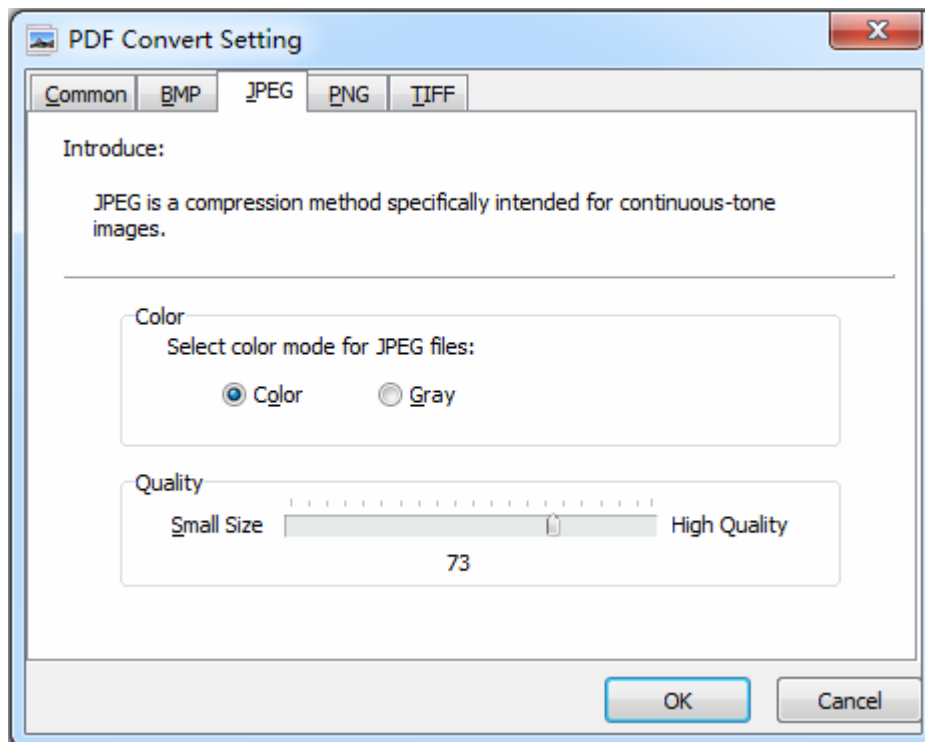
● Nichetargeting options

Wise PDF to Image enables you to output four different formats of images, and different formats of image have different options.

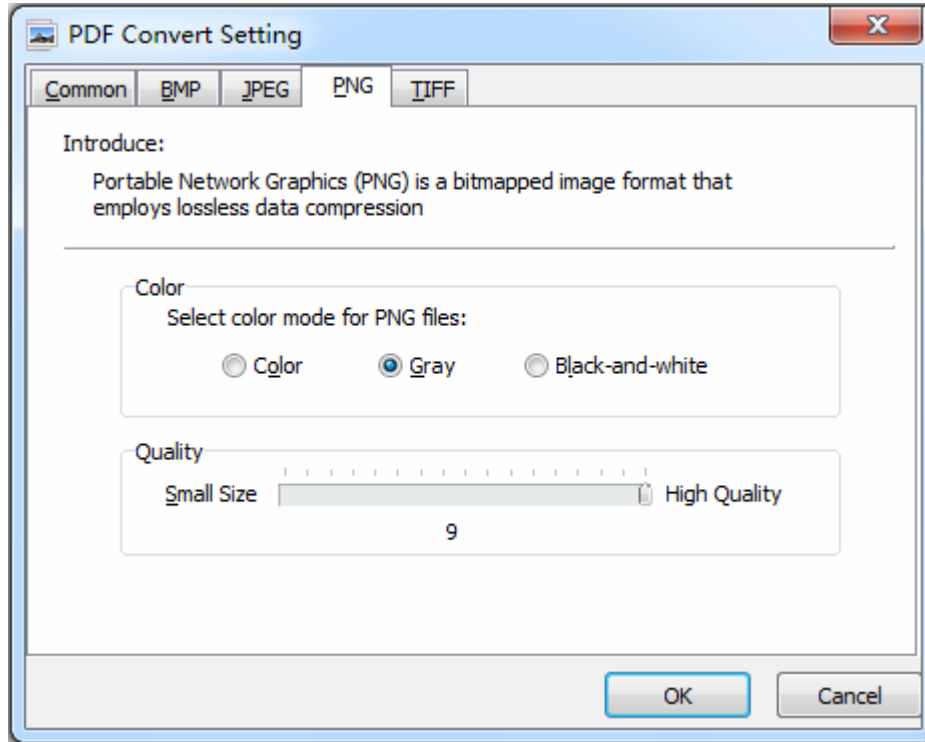

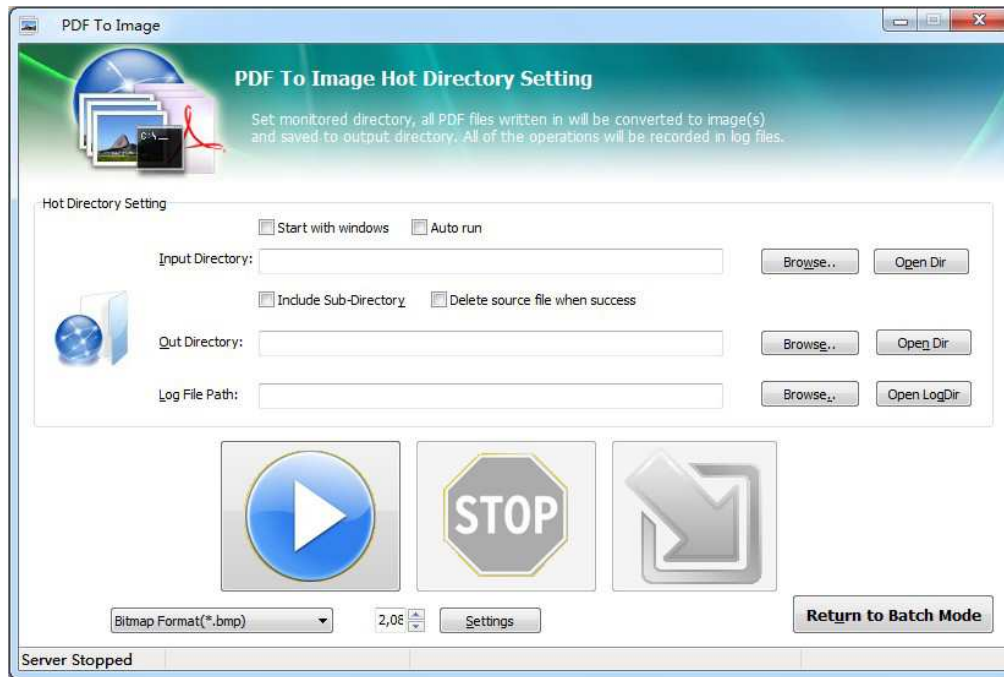



(8) Hot Directories Mode

Hot directories mode allows you to convert any PDF file which are put in the input directory file into image files automatically.
